Each day, we will pray scripture back to God using five different types of prayers: Adoration, Repentance, Petition, Intercession, and Thanksgiving. The verses chosen center (and expand) from Advent themes.

WEEK ONE

Traditionally, the first Sunday of Advent is all about hope, and the first candle of the Advent wreath is called the prophet's candle. This history strengthens our hope, now, as we wait for Jesus' return as King.

DAY ONE, HOPE

(Traditionally, the first Sunday of Advent is all about hope, and the first candle of the Advent wreath is called the prophet's candle. There are over 300 (some say more) prophecies recorded in the Bible that promise the coming of the Messiah. They were fulfilled when Jesus was born. This history strengthens our hope, now, as we wait for Jesus' return as King.)

Adoration & Worship

We praise you, LORD, you are faithful with every promise you speak — This is our hope, and we won't let go! Hebrews 10:23

Repentance & Confession

Forgive us, God, for harboring false hope. You are the only savior, and we set our eyes on you and hope alone in your steadfast love for us. Psalm 33:17-18

Petition (asking for personal needs)

Holy Spirit, you are truth, and I need you. Lead me and teach me so I can put my hope in God all day, every day. Psalm 25:5

Intercession (praying for others)

Father, I pray for my brothers and sisters in Christ, according to your mercy, that we understand the living hope we are born again into. Our imperishable inheritance is to know your son, Jesus! 1 Peter 1:3-4

Thanksgiving

With thanksgiving, LORD, we call this to mind: your mercies never end, they are new every morning. You are faithful! You are our portion! Therefore, we hope in you! Lamentations 3:21-24

DAY TWO, LAMB OF GOD

Adoration & Worship

O Lamb of God, perfect Lamb. You are worthy of all the blessing and honor and glory, Lord! Revelation 5

Repentance & Confession

Forgive me, Lord, for hearing but not doing what you've said. I want to be wise, like one who builds their house on the rock. To hear and do what you say, that is endurance. Matthew 7:24-27

Petition (asking for personal needs)

I want to respond like Abraham, Lord. Put the *here I am* response in my heart and let it rise to early obedience. Genesis 22:1-3

Intercession (praying for others)

Your word says your sheep know your voice, and they will not listen to another—help us, Holy Spirit. Open our eyes to see the life you've laid before us, and open our ears to hear and follow you. John 10:4-5, 11, 27

Thanksgiving

Thank you, Jehovah Jireh, for providing the Lamb, for the sacrifice we could never produce, grow, or gather on our own. Your blood, your life poured out, makes us new. You are faithful! Genesis 22:9-14, Matthew 26:28

DAY THREE, ROOT OF DAVID

Adoration & Worship

DAY FOUR, CORNERSTONE

Adoration & Worship

Petition (asking for personal needs)

Enlarge my heart, Lord, so I can run in your ways. Psalm 119:32

Intercession (praying for others)

Oh that we would stretch our tent pegs, Lord, open wide the curtains, and strengthen our stakes, and possess the land (figuratively and literally) you have given us, Lord of hosts, God of the whole earth. Isaiah 54:2-3, 5

Thanksgiving

Thank you, Jesus, you are the Good Shepherd who saves and leads us to pastures, to springs of living water. Your reign and rule are life and life more abundantly. John 10:9-10, Revelation 7:17

DAY SIX, GREAT LIGHT

Adoration & Worship

DAY SEVEN, YOUR WORD & WAY

WEEK TWO

The second Sunday of Advent centers on the theme of peace, and the candle lit in the wreath is called Bethlehem's candle. This week takes a look at some of the people in the Christmas story, and their journeys of faith, adjusting, beholding, and waiting. We can learn so much from them and the way they responded to what the Lord was doing then, as we lean into what he is doing now.

DAY EIGHT, PEACE

Adoration & Worship

Prince of Peace, the increase of your government and of peace will never end. We are just getting started! Isaiah 9:7

Repentance & Confession

Forgive me, Lord, for harboring offense. You say, Blessed are the peacemakers, they will be called sons of God. Matthew 5:9

I pray for my brothers and sisters in Christ who are faint and overwhelmed. Your word says that even though we will have tribulations, we also have peace because you have overcome the world! John 16:33, Psalm 61:2

Thanksgiving

DAY NINE, JOSEPH & ZECHARIAH

Adoration & Worship

Petition (asking for personal needs)

I need the kingdom of heaven to have a home in me. Come, Jesus, like a little leaven hidden in me that makes a whole loaf of bread rise, like a little seed in me until I grow into a full garden. Matthew 13:31-33

Intercession (praying for others)

Praying for your church, Jesus, that we will not unequally yoke ourselves with the world. There is no partnership between righteousness and lawlessness. There is no fellowship between light and darkness. We are your temple, Living God, and have no agreement with idols. We are your dwelling place alone. You are our God, and we are your people. As your sons and daughters, Lord Almighty, we separate ourselves from the kingdom of darkness. 2 Corinthians 6:14-18

Thanksgiving

We are earthen vessels filled with the treasure of your life, Jesus, proving that the surpassing power belongs to you, and not to us. We are afflicted, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed. We are crucified with you, Jesus, so that your life is manifested in our bodies. How can we say thank you? 2 Corinthians 4:7-10

DAY TWELVE, SON OF THE MOST HIGH

Adoration & Worship

Intercession (praying for others)

That your church would walk as children of light, bearing the fruit of light—all that is good and right and true, and that we would discern what is pleasing to the Lord. Holy Spirit, help us. Ephesians 5:9-10

Thanksgiving

Father, you loved us so much that you gave us your only son. Thank you. We believe in you, Jesus, and are no longer condemned to death, but have eternal life through you. What a savior! John 3:16-18

DAY THIRTEEN, VERY GREAT!

Adoration & Worship

Bless the Lord, O my soul! O Lord my God, you are very great! You are clothed with splendor and majesty, covering yourself with light as with a garment, stretching out the heavens like a tent. Psalm 104:1-2

Repentance & Confession

I want to be wholehearted before you, Lord. As you search the earth, you find me looking back at you. I want to see your strength, your greatness displayed on my behalf. 2 Chronicles 16:9

Petition (asking for personal needs)

Oh that I would strive with the energy you, Lord, powerfully work in me, by proclaiming you, confronting others with wisdom and truth. The hope of glory is you within me, and I want to be fully developed and mature at your coming. Help me, Spirit, be a good steward of what has been so graciously given to me in Jesus. Colossians 1:24-29

As I strive to be excellent at what is good and innocent of evil, come, crush Satan under my feet. Romans 16:19

Intercession (praying for others)

I am praying for those who need healing in their bodies today. Your word says that power goes out from you. So we reach toward you today in faith that you are the healer of our disease. Mark 5:25-34

Thanksgiving

DAY FOURTEEN, STRENGTH IN THE WAITING

Adoration & Worship

We have heard and have come to know that you are the Everlasting God, Everlasting Father is your name, and you are the creator of the earth. You do not grow weary. So, we wait for you, LORD. Isaiah 9:6, Isaiah 40:28

Repentance & Confession

Forgive me, Lord, for allowing my heart, soul, mind, and strength to become drowsy. I want to tarry with you in this hour. My spirit is willing, but my flesh is weak. Teach me to watch and pray so temptation has no place in me. Mark 14:37

Petition (asking for personal needs)

I'm exhausted, LORD. But you give power to the faint and strength to those who have no might. Strength rises as I wait on you. I want to soar like eagles, run, and be weary. I need you! Isaiah 40:29-31

Intercession (praying for others)

For my brothers and sisters in Christ, that we would run the race you've set before us, looking to you, waiting on you. We can do all things, whether in plenty or in hunger, abundance or in need, through you, Jesus, who strengthens us. Philippians 4:12-13, Hebrews 12:1

Thanksgiving

Thank you, Lord, for coming as the Redeemer, for letting us experience redemption. We wait for you, night and day, like Simeon and Anna, to see you come again as King of Kings. Holy Spirit, open our eyes to see the glory of the Lord that is being prepared for us, that will rise on us. Luke 2:25:38

WEEK THREE

The third theme of Advent is Joy. If you're lighting an Advent wreath, this is the Shepherd's candle. Perhaps, more than the other themes, joy is the most understandable. An appropriate example is pregnancy. Carrying a baby for nine months, increasingly more laborious and expectant, until the gladness of hearing and holding the baby is a reality. If we multiply that times an impossible number of years, we might get a glimpse of how joyous the news of the Messiah's arrival would have been. Today, we get to celebrate everything Jesus is and was as we wait, in joy, for what is coming when he returns.

DAY FIFTEEN, JOY

Adoration & Worship

We join with heavenly host, this ancient chorus, to praise you, LORD, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those whom he has favored! Luke 2:14

Repentance & Confession

Have mercy on me, Lord, and restore me with the joy of your salvation. Teach me humility because it is you who holds me together. Psalm 51:12

Petition (asking for personal needs)

Teach me to ponder every word you speak in my heart, and wonder at every fulfillment of your promises. Your word is my treasure, more than gold and silver, so I store it up in my heart. Luke 2:18-19, Psalm 119:72, Psalm 119:11

Intercession (praying for others)

I pray for my brothers and sisters in Christ, that as we tend to what you've called us to do, like the Shepherds, that we will be surrounded by your glory and aware of what you are speaking in this hour. And with haste, we will encourage each other to go and see the thing you have made known to us. Luke 2:8-9, 15-16

Thanksgiving

Thank you, Lord, we have no reason to fear, but you have given us every reason to behold you. You are our savior! You bring good news of great joy for all your people. Through you, Jesus, we are saved from death! Luke 2:10-11

DAY SIXTEEN, JOY OF HIS PRESENCE

Adoration & Worship

You are good, Lord, and your steadfast love endures forever. You've opened the gate of righteousness to us through Jesus. You are our salvation. Others have rejected you, but we build our lives on you. All this, from creation to your birth, your death, your resurrection, and your coming, Lord, is your doing. This is your day, these are your days, we rejoice in them and are glad. Psalm 118:1, 19-24

Repentance & Confession

You, Jesus, are able to keep me from stumbling. I need you. In your joy, your great joy, you present me blameless before the glory of the Father. You alone are savior, be glory and majesty, now and forever. Jude 1:24

Petition (asking for personal needs)

Make known to me the path of life. In your presence, there is fullness of joy, and I need joy. At your right hand are pleasures forevermore, so I'm sitting with you, it's where I belong. You make me glad with the joy of your presence. Psalm 16:11, Psalm 21:6, Acts 2:28

Intercession (praying for others)

That we, your church, would know the joyful shout! Happy are the people who walk in the light of your presence. Psalm 89:16

Thanksgiving

You have turned our mourning into dancing, and in the place of grave clothes, you have dressed us in gladness. Why? So that our glory may sing your praise and not be silent. O Lord our God, we will give thanks to you forever! Psalm 30:11-12

DAY SEVENTEEN, SPIRIT OF JOY

Adoration & Worship

Jesus, you came as a servant to a broken people, and we glorify you for your mercy! God of hope, you fill us with all joy and peace as we continue to trust you. It is in the power of the Holy Spirit that we abound in hope. Romans 15:8-9, 13

Repentance & Confession

Forgive me, LORD, for not walking in the Spirit more. I crucify the flesh with its passions and desires because they are against the Spirit. I belong to you, Jesus! Galatians 5:16-17, 24

Petition (asking for personal needs)

Holy Spirit, come and lead me. Come, bear your fruit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control in me. I want to live by you and keep in step with you. Galatians 5:22-25

Intercession (praying for others)

Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. Instead, we want to be about matters of the kingdom—righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. Galatians 5:26, Romans 14:17

Thanksgiving

Lord, I will rejoice in you always, and then, I will do it again because you are at hand. Without being anxious—rid me of anxiety—I make my requests known to you in thanksgiving. You are the God of peace who guards my heart and mind beyond comprehension. Philippians 4:4-7

DAY EIGHTEEN, FULLNESS OF JOY

Adoration & Worship

You, O Lord, have made me glad by your work; at the works of your hands I sing for joy. Psalm 92:4

Repentance & Confession

I have settled for lesser joys, Jesus. But your desire is for me to remain in you and for you to remain in me. Why? So that your joy may be in me, and my joy may be full. This abiding glorifies the Father! John 15:8-11

Petition (asking for personal needs)

I want to take you at your word, Jesus. You said ask and receive, so I'm asking, and I open my heart to receive what you are providing — make my joy full. John 16:16-24

Intercession (praying for others)

Your joy is our strength, Lord. We believe that we will see your goodness in our lives, in our land, in every detail. So we wait, and stay strong, and take courage in you. Nehemiah 8:10, Psalm 27:13-14

Thanksgiving

We remember, Lord, the great things you have done for us. Our mouths are filled with laughter and our tongues with shouts of joy! Psalm 126:2

DAY NINETEEN, JOYFUL SINGING

Adoration & Worship

You, LORD our God, are right here with us, you save us, and delight over us with gladness! You quiet us with your love, and you rejoice over us with loud, joyful singing. You drive away our oppressor, you gather the lame and outcast, and you restore us. Hallelujah! Zephaniah 3:17-20

Repentance & Confession

Lord, I will not forget to bless you and to remember all your benefits. You heal my disease, redeem me from the pit, you crown me with love and mercy, and you satisfy me with good! I will sing to you, you triumph gloriously. Psalm 103:1-5, Exodus 15:1

Petition (asking for personal needs)

I want to become increasingly aware, Lord, that your salvation is now, but also for the age to come. Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to you always yesterday, today, and forever. I praise and fear you, Jesus! Revelation 19:1-5, Hebrews 13:8

Intercession (praying for others)

Oh, that we, your bride, would get a vision for the Marriage of the Lamb. Let us rejoice and give you glory, that we would make ourselves ready, and clothe ourselves in the righteousness you have provided for us. We are blessed to be invited to this marriage feast! Revelation 19:6-10

Thanksgiving

DAY TWENTY, WISEMEN
